Class Tuitions

Pre-Professional Division – All-Inclusive Tuition Paid in 10 Installments (Sept – June)

- The Pre-Professional Division All-Inclusive Tuition includes all performance costume fees applicable to your student and Nutcracker dinner fees. RDA Festival costs will be billed separately (if applicable)
- PRB offers a 15% discount for families who enroll multiple children. Full tuition is applicable for the highest leveled student, 15% reduction for all other immediate family members enrolled at PRB.

Tuition Policies

Tuition for classes at Pennsylvania Regional Ballet is due and payable by the first day of each month (September through June). Performance costume fees are included in the installment tuition. No tuition deduction or allowance will be made due to the absence, withdrawal or dismissal of the student. Tuition is not transferable and is non-refundable unless withdrawal is due to prolonged illness or injury verified by a doctor's note. Missed classes due to illness or holidays can be made up in a lower level class other than the student's regular class during the same semester in which the class was missed. See School Director for make-up times.

Late Fee Policy

Payment is considered late after the 5th of the month and will be charged a \$25.00 late fee. A \$25.00 late fee will also be applied for declined credit cards. Admission to class may be denied to students with past due accounts.

Class Cancellation

Classes may be cancelled for insufficient enrollment at the discretion of the artistic staff.

Withdrawal From Classes – No Refunds

Once a student is considered "enrolled," tuition is due and expected according to the Tuition Policy unless the office is notified in writing. Students who simply stop attending are still responsible for tuition until the office is notified in writing. No refunds are given. If you need to make special arrangements due to extreme illness or injury, please communicate with the Studio Office. Tuition will be charged – whether you're attending or not – until the office is notified in writing. Accounts more than 90 days past due will be sent to a collection agency.

Master Classes

Master Classes will be held periodically throughout the year. Cost for these classes, for all levels, will be \$20.00.

Summer Program Requirements

All Preparatory through Fifth Year students are required to take a minimum of four (4) weeks in PRB's Summer Program – unless otherwise approved by the Artistic Staff. Attendance in PRB's Summer Program is mandatory to be eligible to audition for the Nutcracker.

Alternate Schedule

While most students who study with us take a full schedule (as listed on our website), PRB does offer a reduced schedule to students who wish to either supplement their ballet training or continue their classes but don't wish to perform.

Summer Program & RDA Festival Payments

Payment options are available for next summer's intensive workshop and RDA/NE Festival (RDA Festival attendance is optional for Third Year students; mandatory for Fourth A&B & Fifth Year students). PRB can accept payments on a monthly, quarterly, or semi-annual basis for either of these programs. PRB's Summer Intensive averages \$1,700 and RDA Festival costs average between \$800 - \$1000. Summer Program payments MUST be completed before the Summer Concert in June.

Inclement Weather – NOTE CHANGE

In the event of inclement weather, please be advised that PRB classes will most likely be cancelled if the East Pennsboro School District cancels its classes or has an early dismissal. Announcements for cancellations will be broadcast on WGAL, ABC27, their websites, posted on our website & Facebook page, and as a message on the Studio telephone messaging system.

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
